EU ENERGY POLICY AFTER 21st CONFERENCE
OF THE PARTIES TO THE UN FRAMEWORK
CONVENTION ON CLIMATE CHANGES (COP21)

The 21st Conference of the Parties to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Changes (COP21) will be held in Paris from 30th November to 11th December 2015. The main goal is that all countries for the first time commit themselves to The Common Agreement in the order to retain the global warming on a level below 2°C. The Agreement should include the countries that emit most of the greenhouse gasses whether they are developed countries or they are developing countries. This Agreement should establish a balance between the Kyoto obligations, i.e. mathematical division of gas emission reduction on the basis of a common upper limit, and the obligations from Copenhagen, which are based on the non-obligatory national engagement without mutually similar characteristics.

The European Union adopted a new climate and energy policy framework for 2030 on 24th May 2014 which implies a greenhouse gas emission reduction by at least 40%. The EU has demonstrated political will for changes, therefore, the problem of defining the goal switches to the choice of measures to conduct the new energy policy.

It is not possible to achieve all the changes in the energy policy due to climate changes without additional investment because the prices of new technologies are higher and therefore additional expenditures are required. For the discussion on the Forum the following questions are being asked: How much do the expenditures for the implementation of the CO₂ emission reduction policy need to be increased, as well as to whom, when, how much and on which way is financial support to be given? For every member state there is an additional question: "How to gain an added value in the economy from the CO₂ emission reduction policy without ending up only with an additional expenditure?"
